2009 – 2010 Tuition Schedule, Assistance Programs, and Commitment

St. Peter Catholic School receives no federal money or outside subsidies to pay for the education of your children nor does the tuition charged meet all the costs of the school. Therefore, we have several fundraisers throughout the year to help offset these costs. Your time, talents, and treasure are required and critical to the St. Peter Mission.

- **2009 – 2010 Tuition**

K4: \$2000    K5 – 5<sup>th</sup> Grade: \$2800

Tuition is payable as a lump sum or under a ten or twelve month payment program.

- **Fundraisers**

It is required that parents work the two major fundraisers critical to ongoing operation of the school; if you choose not to work the fundraisers, you will be charged the following additional sum(s):

Barn Dance (\$500)

Wine Festival/Golf Tournament (\$200)

- **Tuition Assistance Volunteer Subsidy**

We are committed to offering a Catholic education at the most affordable price possible. We offer several tuition reduction options for parents wishing to volunteer to help out at the school. Please note: the number of tuition reduction volunteer opportunities is limited to 21 positions per school year. Eligibility for tuition reduction will be determined upon the basis of need. Parents wishing to volunteer should contact Father Jude, Father Rob, or Rachel at the school office. Volunteer activities include assistance with the Bingo or janitorial programs and potentially other opportunities. All students at St. Peter Catholic School are required to pay some level of tuition. This includes students who are receiving tuition reduction benefits. The required payments for those receiving tuition assistance are set out below.

○Co-payment	1 <sup>st</sup> Child Enrolled	\$100/month or \$1200 annually
	2 <sup>nd</sup> Child Enrolled	\$ 75/month or \$900 annually
	3 <sup>rd</sup> Child Enrolled	\$ 50/month or \$600 annually

○Tuition adjustment credits for the balance of the tuition may be earned by volunteering to assist with the Bingo and school janitorial programs or other school volunteer opportunities.

Please indicate on your tuition reduction application which opportunities you are interested in. (It is important to note that there are only 21 tuition reduction positions available for the school year and it may not be possible to accommodate all requests).

\* PLEASE NOTE: Tuition Adjustments are good for the current academic year and are not carried forward. Tuition credits earned through volunteer activities may not be transferred from one family to another.

If you are interested in the Tuition Assistance Volunteer Subsidy, please sign up. Please request a needs based application at the office. A table explaining the amount of tuition reduction for volunteer activities is available with the application.

- **Parish Subsidy**

Some area Catholic churches offer subsidies for your child's Catholic education. Please inquire at your church office for details.

- **After School Program and Backpack Program**

St. Peter Catholic School will continue to offer these programs. Fees for participation in the programs are as follows.

1 <sup>st</sup> Child	\$3/hour
2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> Child	\$2.50/hour
